MOU Before City Council Executive Committee November 17

The EDACC Foundation, the non-profit group leading development of the Edmonton Galleria, is returning to City Council's Executive Committee November 17 to seek its approval of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Edmonton and the EDACC Foundation. The MOU will set out the terms for the City's contribution of \$58.3M and the Foundation's commitments to the City regarding development and operations.

City Council's Executive Committee unanimously agreed on May 26 to support the Edmonton Galleria and move forward with a MOU. The Foundation and City Administration has been working since then to draft an agreement.

First of Three Architects on Board

The EDACC Foundation has secured the first of three architects to design the Edmonton Galleria. The firm, hired to do the University of Alberta Galleria Campus building design, will be announced once a contract is finalized. Architectural firms for the other aspects of the project are currently being vetted following a Request for Qualifications process. The other two main design projects are a mixed used development with retail, commercial and residential components, and a 1,650 seat main performance hall with rehearsal space and a 200 seat black box theatre.
